<u>BREED HALTER CLASSES</u> - Appaloosa, Quarter Horse & Paint Horse halter classes will be run in accordance with ApHANZ, AQHA & PHANZ rule books. Horses entered in Quarter Horse, Appaloosa & Paint Horses classes must be registered with their respective Associations

WESTERN PERFORMANCE CLASSES - Will be run in accordance with NZWRF rule book.

<u>RANCH RIDING:</u> as per NZWRF/AQHA Rule book – Any horse entered in Ranch riding is not eligible for entry to <u>any</u> Western Pleasure class

<u>AMATEUR</u> - Competitors must hold a current NZWRF Amateur Card which must be carried and shown to the gate steward or a copy sent to the show secretary with entries **NO CARD** - **NO ENTRY**.

JUNIOR HORSE - Horse to be five years & under, to be ridden in a snaffle bit or hackamore with two hands.

SENIOR HORSE - Horse to be six years & over and to be ridden in tack per Rule Q443H of the AQHA Rule Book.

ROOKIE - as per NZWRF rule book

YOUTH - Junior Youth 13 years & under, Senior Youth 14 – 18 years. Age as at 1st August.

ENGLISH CLASSES - In-Hand, Ridden and Hunter classes may be banded, plaited or natural. Height Certificate not required. If large numbers classes may be split by height further on the day.

<u>WORKING HUNTER</u> - Judged on: the way the horse jumps, anything that detracts from a smooth safe trip will lower score, poor jumping form, loose for dangling front legs, consistent take off distance, horses pace (pleasant to ride with long smooth ground covering stride) PDF guideline available if required. Fence Heights: Min 2ft. 6 in. max 2ft 9in.
